Items Required for Most Projects (Must be submitted at time of application for permit)

- 1. Site Plan- (i.e. Construction Stakeout Drawing or Proposed Plot Plan)
- (a) On lots less than two (2) acres-in-ground and above ground swimming pools-Site plan must be certified by Registered Land Surveyer.
- (b) On lots of two (2) acres or greater and not in a subdivision- in ground or above ground pools- Site plan is not required to be certified by Registered Land Surveyor, But must be a <u>scaled</u> drawing <u>showing all existing structures including septic tank and field and proposed construction.</u>
- 2. Manufacturer's installations are required for above-ground swimming pools.
- Certificate of Completion and Compliance: To be signed by contractor and owner.
- Electrical Contractor Sign-off Sheet is required for in-ground pools. A
 Bartholomew County Licensed Electrician must do all the electric work. All
 sign-off sheets must be submitted prior to the permit being issued.

Additional Items That May Be Required

5. Health Department Septic Permit or Evaluation Report: if on septic system. A fee is charged by the Health Department for these services. Bartholomew County Health Department 812-379-1550.

Architectural Committee Approval if required by subdivision. Contact your Homeowners Association, Real Estate Agent or Developer.

Please Note: This is a general list of those items necessary for the evaluation and issuance of a permit in Columbus/Bartholomew County. Upon review and depending on the particular situation more documents or information may be requested. Please allow 3-5 days for review of your permit when planning your project start time. **NO** inspections will be done prior to the issuance of a permit for work.

Attached is information to assist you in understanding and complying with swimming pool permits and inspections. This information applies to both in-ground and permanently installed above-ground pools.

Pool installations must comply with all current local zoning ordinances and local, state and national codes. **Inspections are required!** We normally conduct at least two inspections during construction of the pool as outlined below.

- 1. Bonding inspection and inspection of any underground electric and plumbing.
- 2. Final inspection after all work is completed including the safety barrier as required by the Indiana Swimming Pool Code; before pool is put into use.
